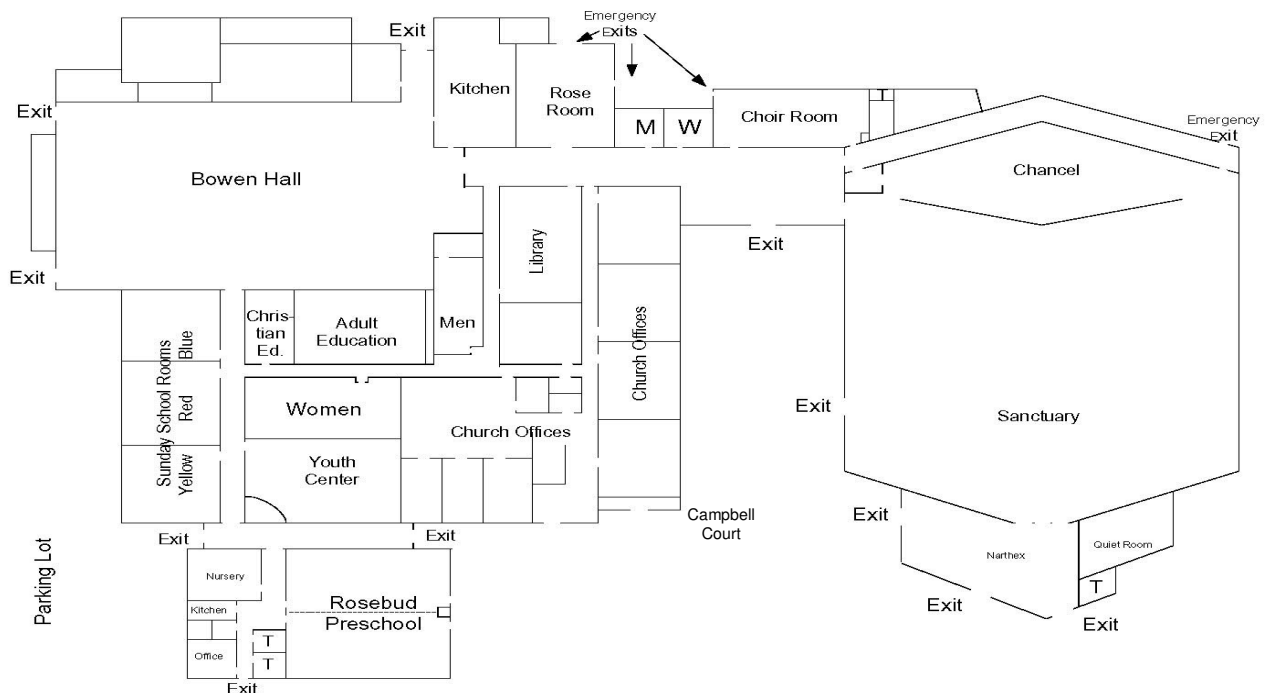
PASTORAL CARE & CONCERN Our staff cares about you, your concerns, & your questions about living the Christian faith. We encourage you to be in touch with us. For personal conversation, please contact our Pastor directly to arrange a mutually agreeable time. Or you may correspond via other means: letter, fax (542-5109) or e-mail.

NURSERY CARE: All ages are welcome in our worship. We have a well-supplied nursery at the back of the sanctuary where parents may go with their young children if necessary. A baby changing station is located in the room next door to the women's large restroom, near the Sunday school rooms.

SUNDAY SCHOOL: Ages 2-4 check in with the Sunday School Superintendent, and then they may go to their room (Yellow Room) before worship. After the Children's Time, older children may stay in worship or ages 4 through grade 6 go to Sunday School in the Blue/Red Room. Youth class meets in the Youth Room normally; on Communion Sunday the Youth Class stays in the Sanctuary.

HEARING ASSISTANCE We have two types of hearing assistance in the sanctuary. First is an FM receiver with ear buds. Second is the loop system which works through the T-coil on your hearing instrument. Let the sound technician know if you hear all right or if the sound quality is not good.
