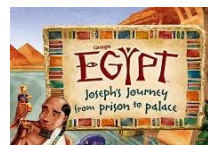

# UNITY!

*By Pastor Cindy*

*Behold how good and pleasant it is when our brothers and sisters dwell in **unity!** (Psalm 133: 1)*

Like a parent who is troubled about their children's quarrels, God is troubled when her children do not get along and fail to promote peace and unity in the church. Our God is great and wants us all to work for unity and peace while appreciating and loving the wonderful diversity of his creation.



I am proud of our church for having a rainbow flag up in front of our building to show we don't just **say** in our church vision statement that we are "reaching out with nurturing love to all..." but we **practice** hospitality and inclusivity as well.

Since I have Scottish heritage and my clan comes from the region of Alloway, Scotland, I was truly joyful when I read that in May of 2015, our ancestral Church of Scotland joined the PCUSA in allowing the ordination of people who are gay. The outgoing Moderator Very Rev John Chalmers said: *"We cannot go on suffering the pain of internal attacks which are designed to undermine the work or the place of others.*

*It's time to play for the team."* He added: *"It is time to stop calling each other names, time to shun the idea that we should define ourselves by our differences and instead define ourselves by what we hold in common - our baptism into Christ, our dependence on God's grace, our will to serve the poor and so on."*

According to BBC news, "The vote followed a church-wide debate and consultations with all 45 presbyteries, which voted 31 to 14 in favor of change. Supporters said it was time for the church to be inclusive and recognize the "mixed economy" of modern Scotland."

Baptist minister, Reverend Daryl Evans wrote a blog for a website called "What Christians Want to Know" and he listed many scripture passages on "unity." Reverend Evans said: *"Throughout the centuries the church has had a difficult time in agreeing with each other. There are obviously numerous denominations and even many differences even within denominations. There are many reasons for this dynamic. Sometimes church traditions and differing biblical interpretations get in the way of unity. But what does the Bible say about unity? There are many biblical passages that explain what Christian unity should be."*

The following list is a sampling of the many scriptures on "unity:"

**1 Peter 3:8** *"Finally, all of you, have unity of mind, sympathy, love, a tender heart, and a humble mind."*

**John 13:35** *"By this all people will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another."*

**John 17:23** *"I in them and you in me, that they may become perfectly One, so the world may know that you sent me and loved them as you loved me."*

**Acts 4:32** *"Now the full number of those who believed were of one heart and soul, and no one said that any of the things that belonged to them was their own, but they had everything in common".*

**Philippians 2:1-3** *"So if there is any encouragement in Christ, any comfort from love, any participation in the Spirit, any affection and sympathy, complete my joy by being of the same mind, having the same love, being in full accord and of one mind. Do nothing from selfish ambition or conceit, but 2*



*in humility count others more significant than yourselves”.*

**Colossians 3:14** *“And above all these put on love, which binds everything together in perfect harmony.”*

**1 John 4:12** *“.... if we love one another, God abides in us and his love is perfected in us.”*

**Romans 12:10** *“Love one another with affection. Outdo one another in showing honor.”*

**Ephesians 4:3** *“...be eager to maintain the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.”*

**1 Corinthians 12:12** *“For just as the body is one and has many members, and all the members of the body, though many, are one body, so it is with Christ. For in one Spirit we were all baptized into one body—Jews or Greeks, slaves or free—and all were made to drink of one Spirit.”*

**1 Corinthians 12:26** *“If one member suffers, all suffer together; if one member is honored, all rejoice together.”*

**Galatians 3:28** *“There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither slave nor free, there is no male and female, for you are all One in Christ Jesus.”*

**Ephesians 4:11-13** *“The gifts he gave were that some would be apostles, some prophets, some evangelists, some pastors and teachers, <sup>12</sup>to equip the saints for the work of ministry, for building up the body of Christ, <sup>13</sup>until all of us come to the unity of the faith...”*

**Romans 12:16** *“Live in harmony with one another. Do not be haughty, but associate with the lowly. Never be wise in your own sight.”*

**1 Corinthians 1:10** *“I appeal to you, by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that all of you agree, and that there be no divisions among you, but that you be united in the same mind and the same judgment.”*

God’s word shows the importance of unity. Today, you may be holding a grudge or ill feelings towards another. My prayer for you is that you give that up to God. Show the love and forgiveness that comes from the Holy Spirit and be at peace with all.

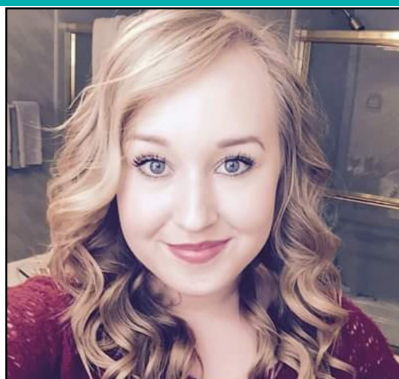

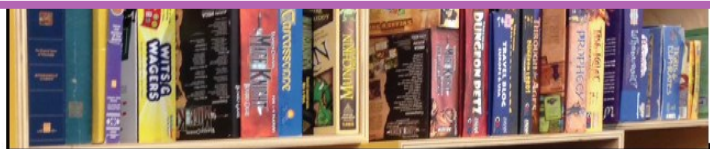

# COMMITTEE UPDATES

## Finance

Through April we are on budget with expenses but behind in pledged and unpledged revenue. Now some of this could just be a quirk in our system, let me explain. If a member pledges \$2,000 for 2016, our system assumes the pledge will come in regular, even monthly giving of 2,000/12 or \$166.67/month. So by April, the system will show 4 x 166.67 or \$666.68 of budgeted revenue. But on this member's pledge card, had they indicated they would pay semi-annually with two \$1,000 payments in June and December, the member is on track but our system would reflect that we are \$666.68 behind budget. Now that I have thoroughly confused you, please be certain you are up to date with your 2016 pledge.

Cash reserves remain adequate. We have an unexpected facility repair cost of approximately \$5,000 that will be paid for out of reserves.



We have regretfully discontinued the Sunday Morning Bible Class. Look for a survey soon in the Sunday bulletin that will help us discover what days and times are good for you and what you would like to study. Watch for announcements of a Summer Evening Class. The Rose Room Video Library has many interesting videos you can check out to view at home.

Plans for the Vacation Church School, June 13-17, are in the works but more helpers are needed. Contact Diane Osten to volunteer (838-7165 Petmom@sonic.net) The program focuses on the story of Joseph and his brothers. Kids will learn a lot about ancient Egypt. Coming soon: Summer family movies on Wednesday evenings.

## Personnel

The May meeting was held on Tuesday May 10. Present Chair Jim Taylor, Robert Cortez, and Pastor Cindy Alloway. The committee spent the meeting time discussing the job description and duties for Director of Family Ministries. Staff evaluations will be reviewed at the June meeting.

## Session

They were welcomed by the congregation on May 1 and May 8. The session also reinstated Vicki Burnett as a COR member and removed Kathleen Rhodes who is attending another church.

Pastor Cindy informed us of her planned trip to India (late July/early August). She also let us know that she will not seek another term as a representative from the Presbytery of the Redwoods to Synod. The session voted to approve the employment of Nancy Morgan as Finance Administrator and Cheyenne Hernandez as Children's Program Coordinator/Teacher.

Following the successful Chili Cook Off, Church and World is making plans for a similar event next year, with changes to improve speed of access to food. Christian Education is preparing for this year's Vacation Church School, and Diane Osten is seeking volunteers for this program June 13-17. Chris Nelle reported that while cash reserves are adequate and expenses are in line with budget, pledge income is still below stated pledges. Deborah Baker noted that Fellowship is seeking assistance with the Coffee Hour after church in Bowen Hall.

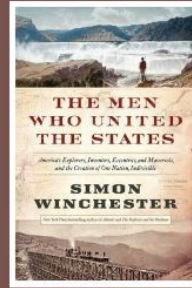

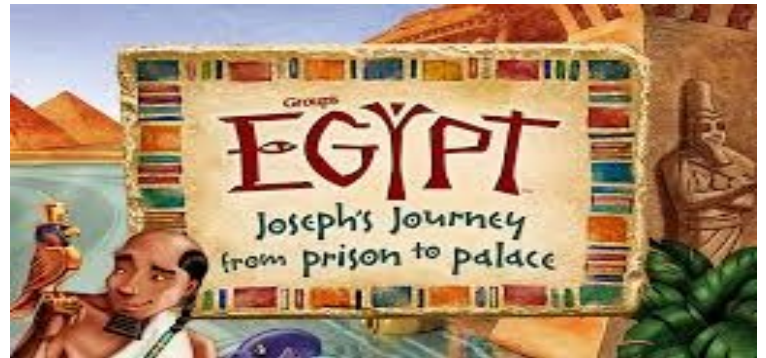
