Lord, the Lily of the Valley, stand by me.



Did you know? "Be Still, My Soul" was first penned by Katharina von Schlegel about 1752 in turbulent post-Reformation Germany. Katharina was a canoness of a women's seminary of the Pietist movement which stressed personal holiness, charity, missions and music. This song was lost to the English speaking world until Jane Laurie Borthwick translated it in about 1855. The tune was written by Jean Sibelius (Finlandia).


