

<u>Reader #1:</u> Today is the second Sunday of Advent. Advent is a time of waiting, and watching, and wondering.

<u>Reader #2:</u> God's light comes through Jesus to show us the way back to God's divine love and light.

<u>All:</u> The prophet Malachi proclaimed: "The LORD All-Powerful, will send a messenger to prepare the way. Then suddenly the Lord you are looking for will appear in his temple. The messenger you desire is coming with God's promise, and he is on his way."


