

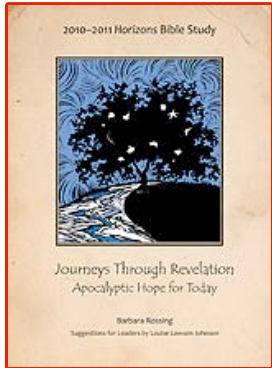


Presbyterian Women's Purpose
