Did You Know?

The PCUSA guide for services of Healing and Wholeness states:

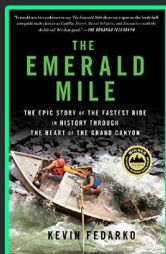

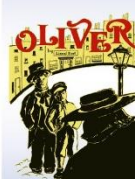
