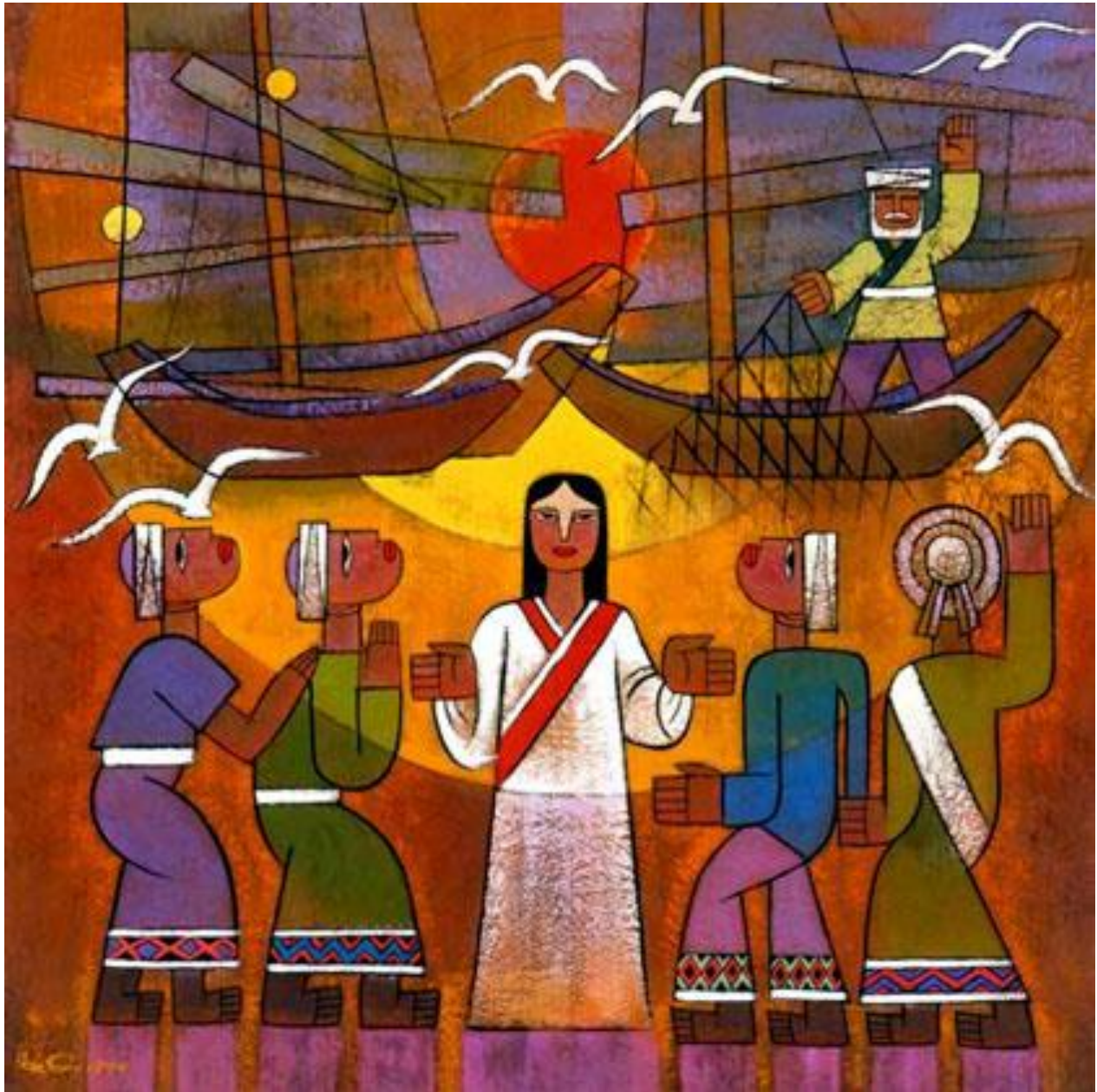

STATEMENT OF ORDINATION AND INSTALLATION
