

PRAYER OF THE PEOPLE

- <u>All:</u> We pray for all those afflicted with COVID-19, and all those impacted by this world pandemic.....for all medical personnel, nurses, for public health officials, and all civic leaders. Grant them courage and prudence as they seek to respond to this emergency with compassion and in service to the common good.

One: We pray for those who are facing death and for those who mourn,

whom we name in our hearts.....(silent prayer) We give thanks for all those who have strengthened our faith that we, too, might be a sign to the world of your steadfast love, hope, and grace; through Jesus Christ, who taught us to pray saying:

(The Lord's Prayer) Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name. Thy kingdom come, thy will be done, on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread; and forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors. And lead us not into temptation but deliver us from evil. For thine is the kingdom and the power and the glory, forever. Amen.
