

Let us lift up all those affected around our planet by the CoVid 19 pandemic: We pray for ...

those who are sick and suffering;

those who are grieving the loss of loved ones;

medical personnel and church leaders who work to help and heal;

those who are subjected to racist abuse and discrimination;
