GET TO KNOW YOUR PREACHER...Martha Madrid de Lopez

I was born and raised in Mexico City. At a young age I knew my call was to serve my Lord, Jesus Christ. I enrolled myself at the Theological Reformed Seminary John Calvin in Mexico City. The National Presbyterian Church in Mexico does not ordain women in ministry. Nevertheless, I got my BA in Theology and started working in different churches in Mexico City; leading bible studies, spiritual retreats, women groups, VBS and developing Christian education programs and preaching as a guest speaker. Fifteen years ago, I received a job offer from a small congregation in Northern California; so I followed the call from the Lord and moved to the United States to a very small town, Fort Bragg. There, I started working with the Hispanic - Latino Congregation, Los Amigos the Cristo, who were part of the First Presbyterian Church in Fort Bragg.

Living in this country gave me the opportunity to become a Commissioned Lay Pastor at that time. Since then, I have been working with Spanish speaking people. I started preaching in English more frequently and working more with the Anglo congregation, developing Christian Education programs and youth groups. A few years later I became a Candidate for Ordination. Occasionally, I get invitations to preach at different churches around my area. I continue helping my church in different ministries. I also have a job at one of the elementary schools as an administrative assistant. In Fort Bragg.

I met the love of my life, Oscar, who is a Law Enforcement Officer at our Police Department. He has been my partner, my friend, my support in all aspects of my life and especially in my ministry. We have been able to combine our strengths and abilities to communicate with people of all backgrounds in our little community. We have a nine-yearold daughter who enjoys nature, science and animals. I am very delighted for the opportunity to worship with you this morning.
