

What do ushers do here? The church usher is usually the first smiling and welcoming face a member or visitor will engage in arriving for a service. Their appearance and demeanor can magically change a state of mind from apprehension to comfort and reception.

They do offertory collections, light candles, make a count of attendees, and much moremost importantly help in the case of an emergency (medical, evacuation etc.) Training is provided. Ushers generally volunteer once a month on a Sunday morning. Often ushers are asked to volunteer at other events such as concerts or life celebrations.
